That's about 80 million people, due to the environmental and attitudinal barriers often related to a full participation in society and economy will be hindered. For people with disabilities is the poverty rate 70% on average, which is partly due to their limited access to the world of work.

More than a third of the 75-year-olds have disabilities that affect them to some extent, and over 20% are severely impaired. These percentages are likely to rise further as the population is aging in the EU.
